About the Role

This is a unique opportunity for an experienced maintenance worker to join the Maintenance Team at BeWILDerwood Norfolk.

The role will be responsible for the general maintenance of the park including:

- Daily structural checks
- Maintenance of the park structures, including replacing of load-bearing uprights, decking, roofing, staircases and play equipment
- Maintenance of the park infrastructure, including office buildings, electrical and water systems, and catering/retail units
- Basic park upkeep such as fencing, pathway repair, sanding & painting.
- Occasional involvement supporting the creation of new play and events structures

★ This is a very hands-on role with the majority of work being outside in all conditions so candidates will need to be adaptable and positive, whatever the weather! The ideal candidate will have the ability to work as part of a small team and use their own initiative and work alone when necessary. Qualifications in carpentry would be desirable and experience working with wooden structures or play equipment would be bonus. A general knowledge of repairs and maintenance are essential to this role, along with a proactive, enthusiastic attitude towards work.
